



## Aa

A is for amphibians. The word *amphibian* means double life. Amphibians spend part of their lives under water and spend the other part on land.














E is for eggs.
As some of us know, frogs lay their eggs in clusters and toads lay their eggs in chains.


















M is for muskrats. Muskrats are mammals that have brown thick fur.
