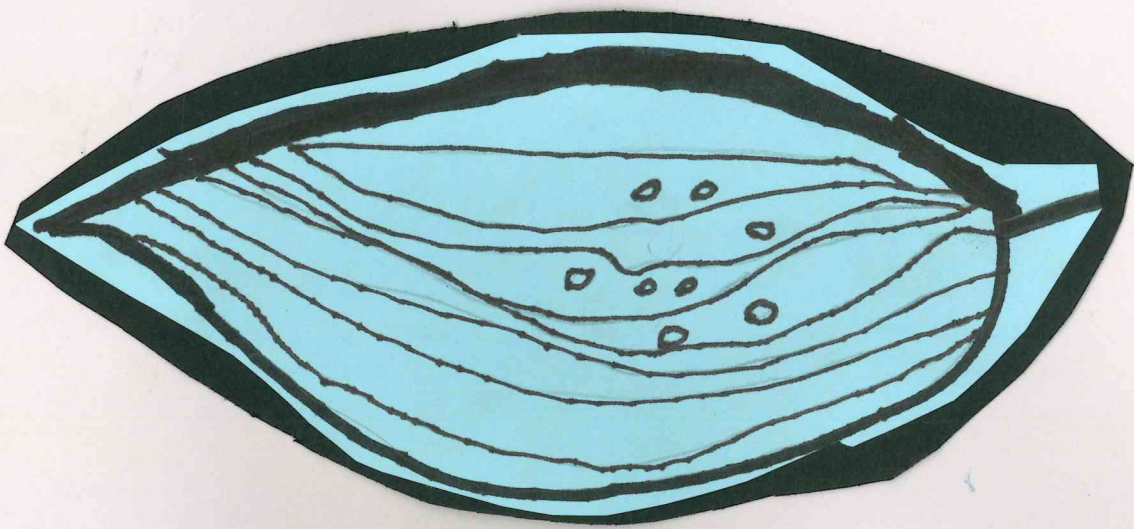


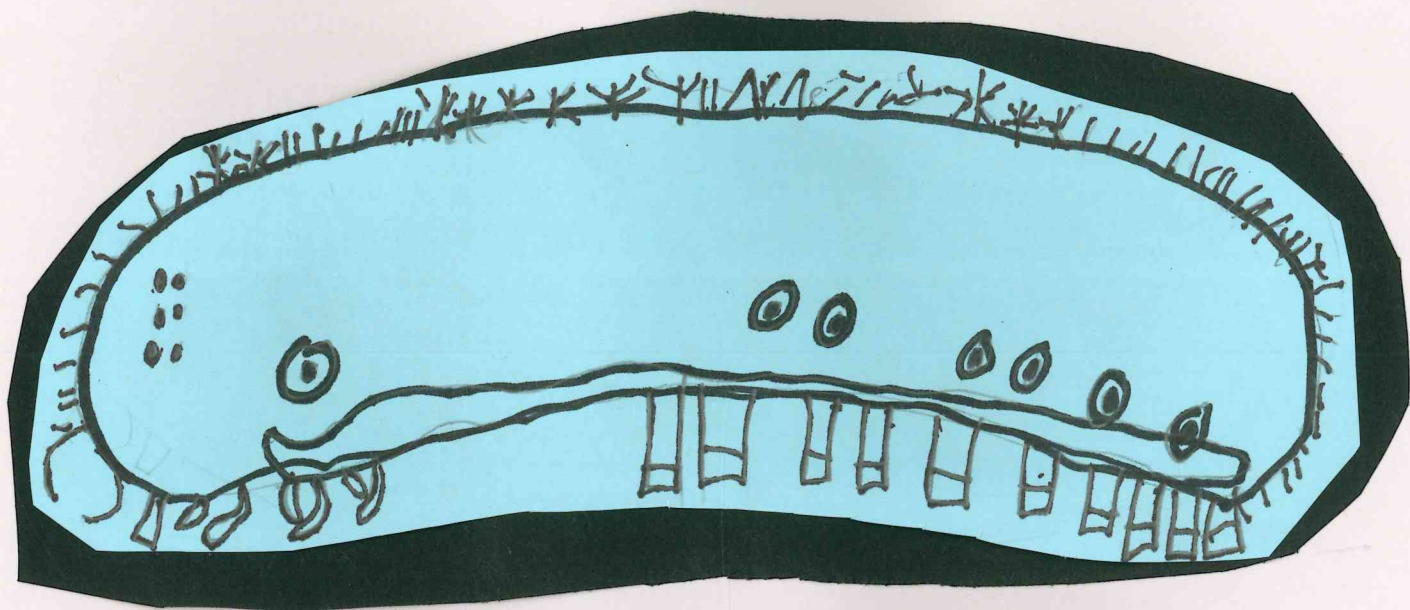
A Life Cycle of a Butterfly

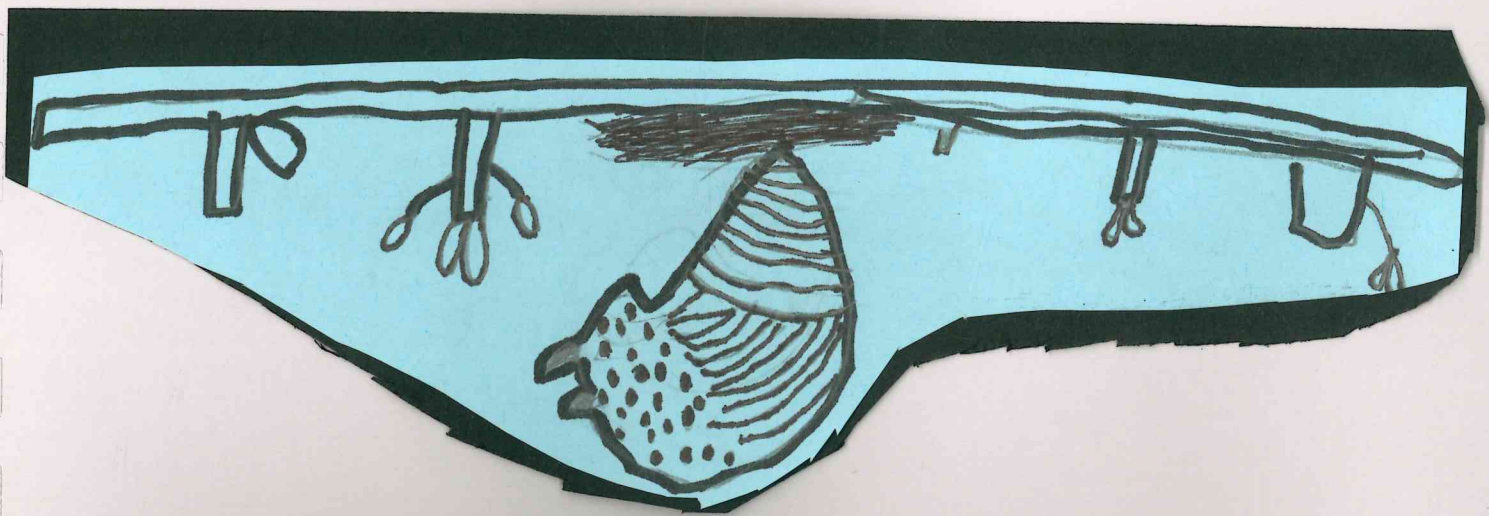




The egg is sticky.
