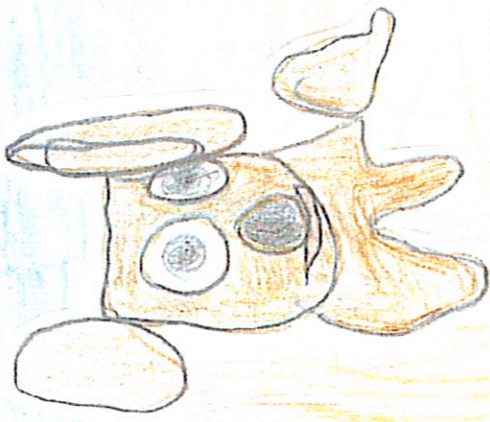


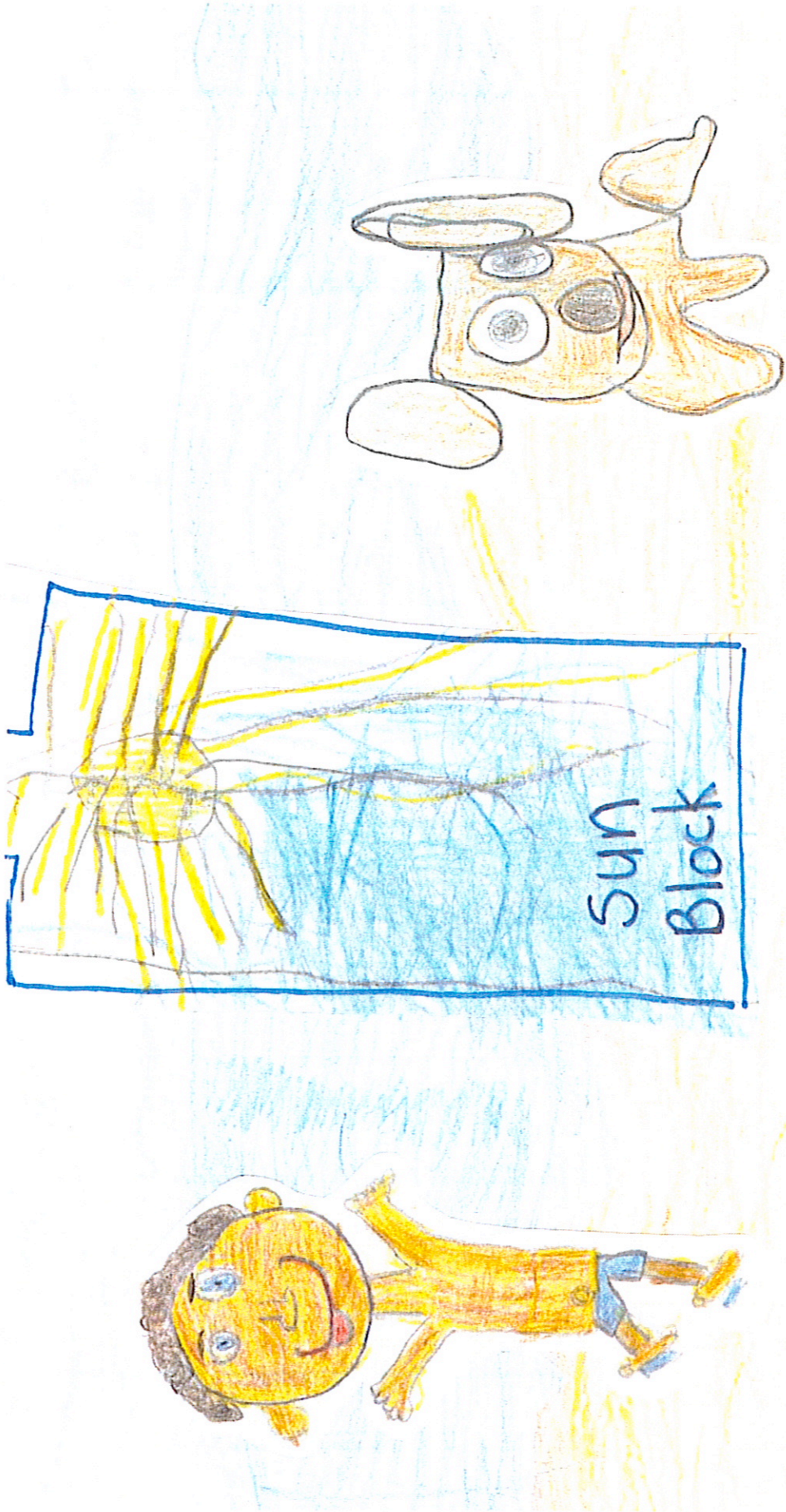


If You Take A Dog to the

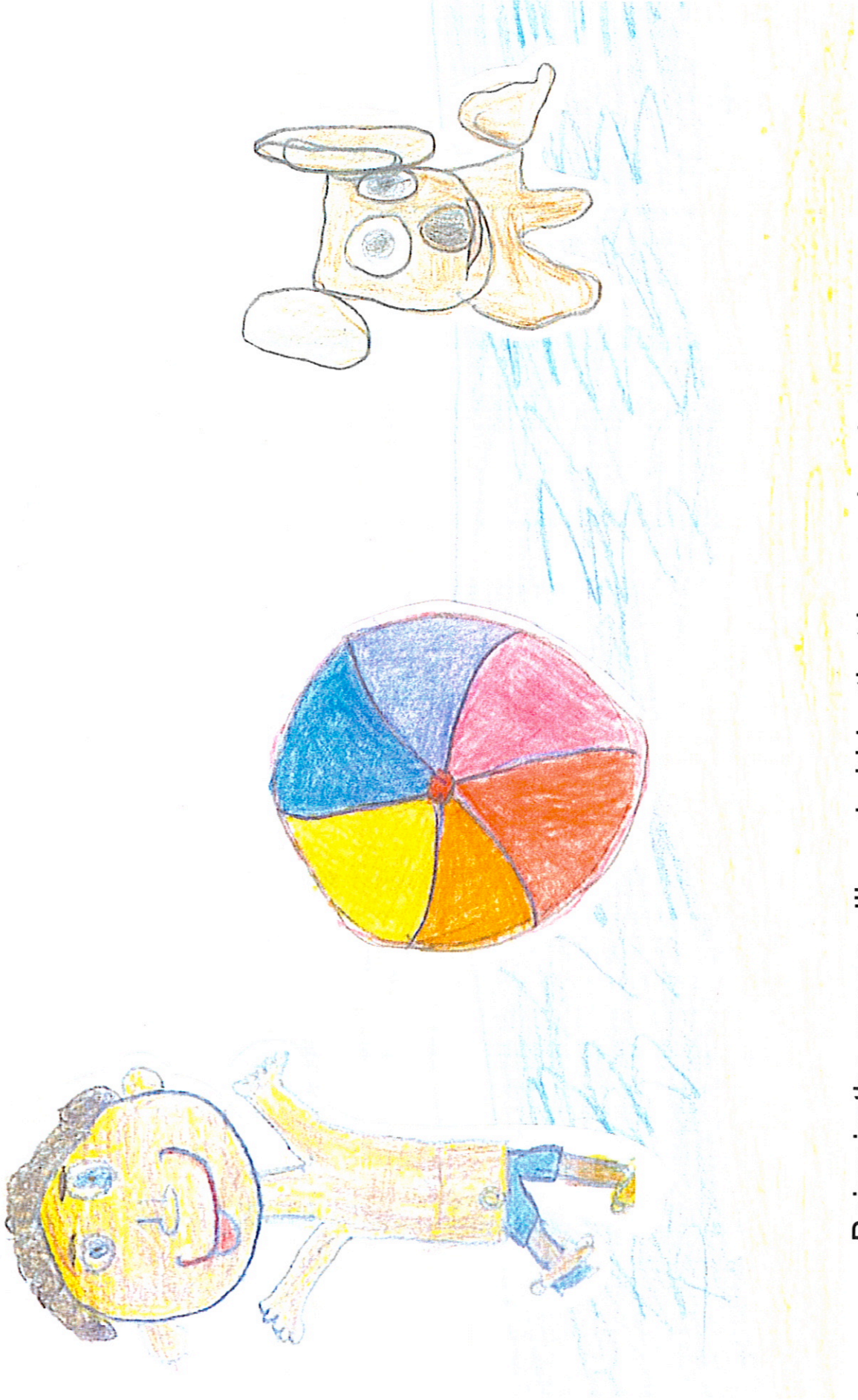
If you take a dog to the beach, he'll ask you for some sunglasses.

He'll see children splashing in the ocean and he'll want to go in and splash too.



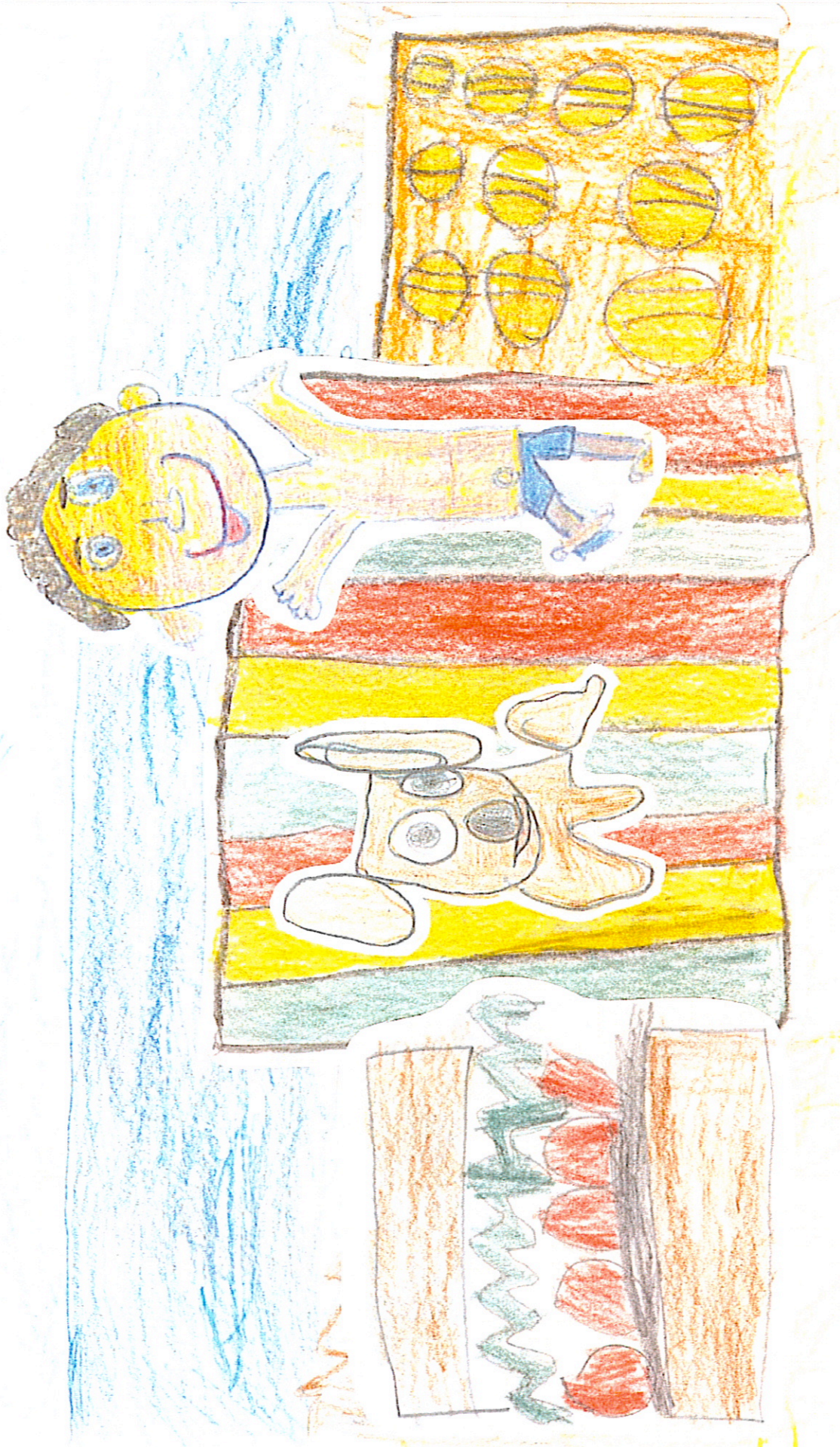
Being in the ocean will remind him that he needs a beach ball to play with.



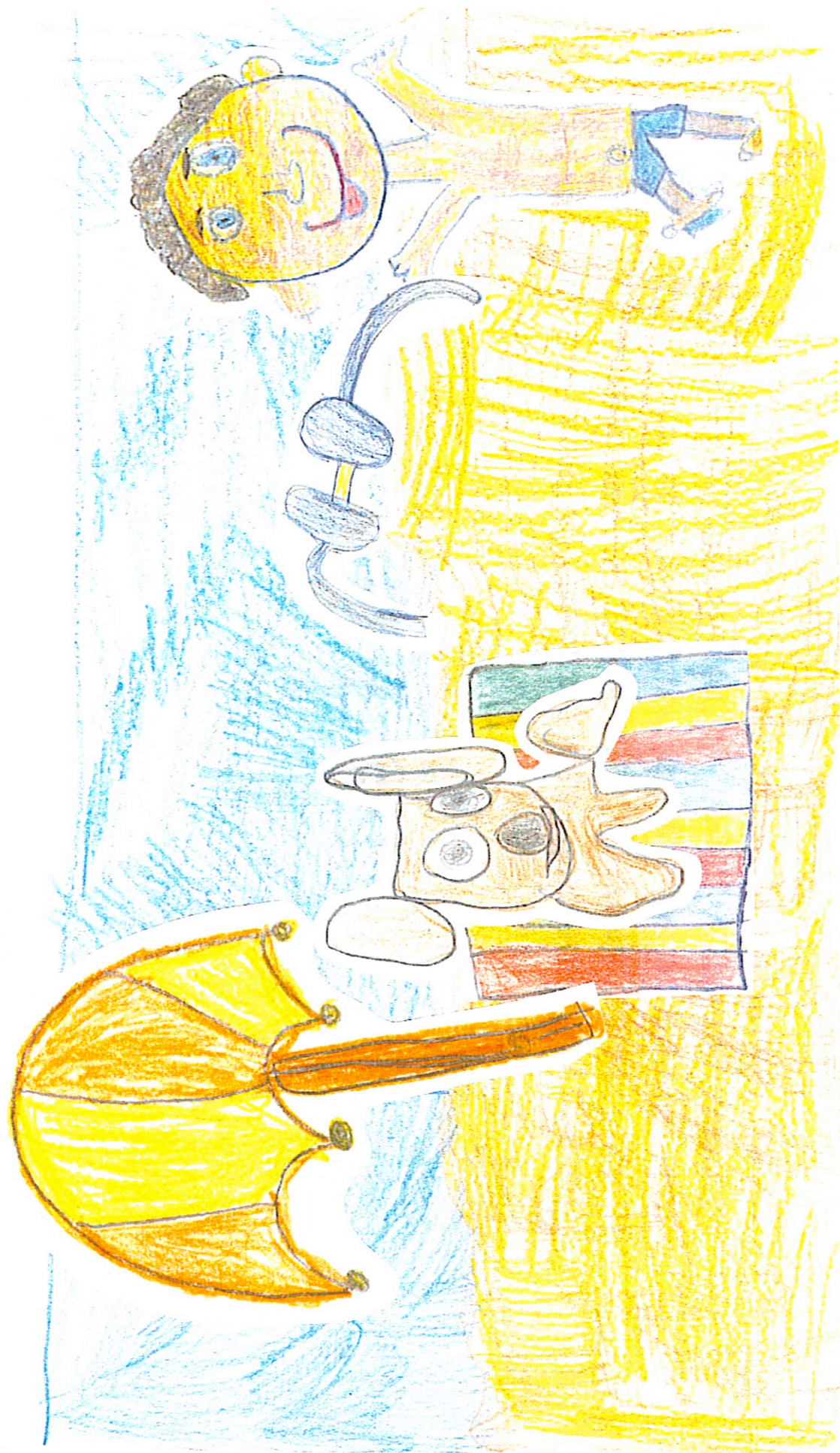
The water is cold so he'll want to get out and look for seashells and crabs.
