## Old Man Palm

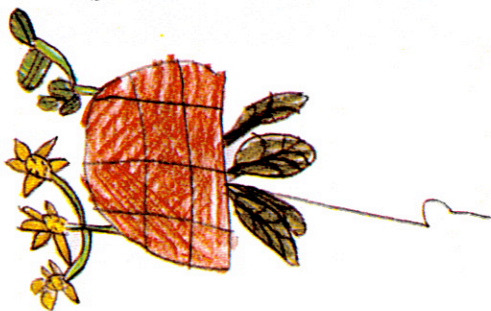
- It got its name because of the shaggy, hairy growth that covers the trunk of the tree.

- This plant is hung because the stems of this orchid grow through the potting mix and hang out at the bottom of the basket.



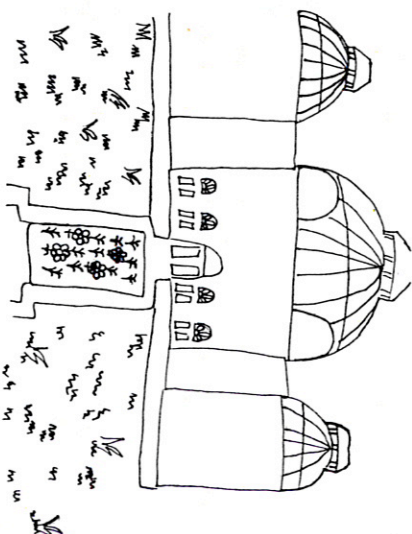
## Pitcher Plant

- This tree got its name because the leaves are shaped like a fox's tail.



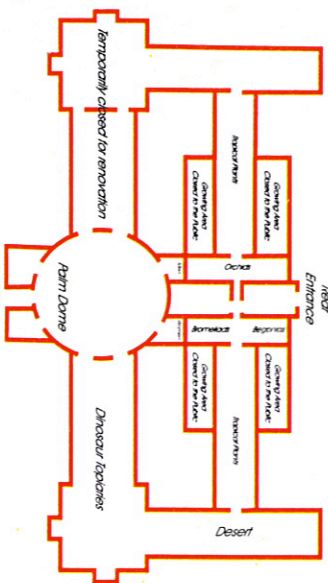
## Bottle Palm

## Monkey Puzzle Tree

- This has a spiny trunk.

## Prickly Cycad

## Swiss Cheese Vine

- It got its name because of the holes in the leaves.
- The holes help water & sunlight get to lower plants.

## Barrel Cactus

- Has a jelly-like substance inside of it.
- The substance stores water for the plant.



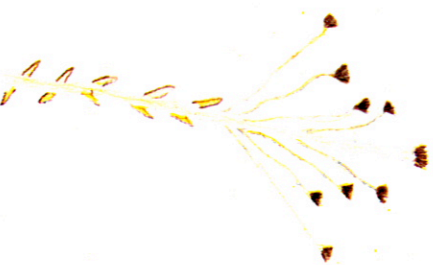
## Milkbush

## Prayer Plant

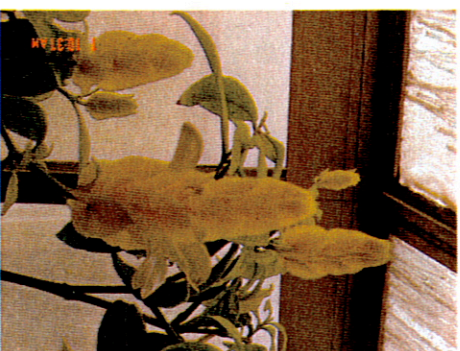
- The leaves on this plant close at night and open during the day time.

## Lollipop Plant
