



Inch by Inch, Row by Row, How does my Garden Grow?



Cherry tomatoes go in the pizza, salad and KinderCREW favorites gardens.







Ben planted the dill seeds on March 17th. Dill needs full sun to grow. You can harvest dill in 40-60 days. Its leaves are shaped like pine needles. Dill tastes like grass and feels smooth. It is green and yellow and it has leaves. Dill is used to make pickles and goes well in soups. Dill is in the pickle, herb, and KinderCREW favorites gardens.





Jalapeno peppers go in the salsa, pickle, and KinderCREW favorite gardens.









Brenna planted the radish seeds on March 17th. Radishes need full sun to grow. You can harvest radishes in 25 days. Radishes are white and red and shaped like a carrot. Radishes are spicy. They are crunchy to eat and oily to feel. Radishes go in the pickle and salad gardens.




Cait planted the roma tomato seeds on March 17th. Roma tomatoes need full sun to grow. You can harvest roma tomatoes in 76 days. They have green stems, red fruit, and are really pretty. They are oval. Roma tomatoes taste bad because I don't like them. They feel soft, but kind of hard. They are smooth. Roma tomatoes go in the salsa, pasta and soup garden.



Colin planted the rosemary seeds on March 17th. Rosemary needs full sun to grow. You can harvest rosemary in 90-400 days. Rosemary leaves are green, pointy and look like pine needles. They are also smooth and soft. The stem is red and brown. Rosemary is spicy and crunchy. Rosemary goes in the herb and soup gardens.



Sofia planted the spearmint seeds on March 17th. Mint needs full or part sun to grow. You can harvest mint in 90-200 days. Spearmint is a light green, poky leaf. It tastes like cool toothpaste. Spearmint feels soft. Spearmint goes in the herb garden and can be made into tea.



Malia planted the sweet pepper seeds on March 17th. Sweet peppers need full sun to grow. You can harvest sweet peppers in 70 days. Sweet peppers are green and yellow. They taste sweet which is why they are called sweet peppers. They have a square top and round bottom! They are smooth and are shiny when you wash them. The inside is wet and sometimes crunchy when you bite them. Sweet peppers go in the pizza, salad, salsa and pickle gardens.
